Dear City of Pevely Resident,

Waste Management of Missouri would like to take this opportunity to thank the City of Pevely for selecting Waste Management as its environmental services partner. We appreciate your business!

The City of Pevely and Waste Management have entered into a 3-year agreement for residential environmental services. This environmental services contract includes trash and recycling collection service, and takes effect February 1st, 2021.

Waste Management is pleased to provide City residents with the following services:

<u>BASE SERVICE</u>	<u>OPTIONAL SERVICES</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Who: All residents of Pevely who have an active utility billing account may participate in the City's trash and recycling program. ○ What: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Residential trash service includes 1 96-gallon cart provided to all homes in Pevely at no additional cost. Residents can place their included cart as well as adjacent bags of trash or personally owned containers at the curb on collection day. All trash must be contained within the provided cart, personally owned container or within a bag. Loose trash will not be collected. ○ Residential recycling collection includes 1 64-gallon cart provided to all homes in Pevely at no additional cost. Recycling will be limited to the contents of the cart and cannot be left in piles on the ground. Additional carts are available for a small fee. ○ Residents may also place 1 bulky item at the curb each week at no additional charge. A complete list of acceptable bulk items is attached to this letter. ○ When: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Trash service will continue to be provided on Monday each week. ○ Recycling service will continue to be provided on Thursday each week. ○ All residents must have their trash and recycling at the curb by 6:00 AM on service day to ensure the WM drivers are able to complete your service. As service times do vary from time to time, it's important to have your items out early, even if your driver normally comes at a specific time of the day. ○ Where: Residents should place their carts and/or personally owned containers and bags of trash at the curb for collection. Please ensure there is at least 3 feet of spacing between WM carts and additional containers/bags of trash or bulky items. ○ How Much: Residential trash and recycling service will cost \$25.70 per home per month and will be paid through your City utility billing account. Prices will be adjusted annually by 3.5%. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Optional Yard Waste Collection Service <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Optional, subscription yard waste service is available for \$5.00 per month ○ Yard waste service is billed directly to the resident by Waste Management. Residents can subscribe by contacting Waste Management customer service at 1-800-964-8988. ○ Service is provided the 1st Wednesday of every month. ○ Service is limited to 10 bags/bundles per month. ○ Billing will be made quarterly ○ Additional Trash and Recycling Carts <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Additional trash and recycling carts are available for rental from Waste Management for \$2.00 per month. ○ Residents are billed directly by Waste Management for this service. ○ Billing will be made quarterly ○ Waste Management will replace broken carts at no cost to the resident ○ Additional Bulky Item Collection Service <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Residents who need more than the 1 included item per week disposed of can use the additional bulky item collection service. ○ Additional bulky items are \$10 each ○ Bulk items should be scheduled in advance by contacting Waste Management customer service at 1-800-964-8988. ○ Billing for this service will be made direct to the resident by Waste Management. ○ Optional Appliance Recycling Service <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Residents who need appliances removed can utilize Waste Management's appliance recycling service. ○ Residents should contact Waste Management customer service at 1-800-964-8988 to schedule the collection. ○ The cost for this service is \$25 per item ○ Billing will be made direct to the resident for this service.

Set out ALL environmental services items by 6:00 a.m.



Garbage Guidelines:

- Base price for Revely = **\$25.70** per month.
- Waste Management has been contracted to collect items inside the cart, as well as bagged or containerized items adjacent to the cart.
- All residents receive 1 96 gallon cart as part of base service. Smaller 64 gallon carts are available at no additional charge.
- Additional 96 gallon garbage carts may be requested for a fee of \$2.00 extra per month.
- Additional 64 gallon garbage carts may be requested for a fee of \$1.00 extra per month.



Bulky Item Guidelines:

- One item free per week per home on trash day. Appliances are not included.
- Weight limit is not to exceed what two average men can carry. Items larger than 60 lbs please call to schedule special collection.



Yard Waste Guidelines:

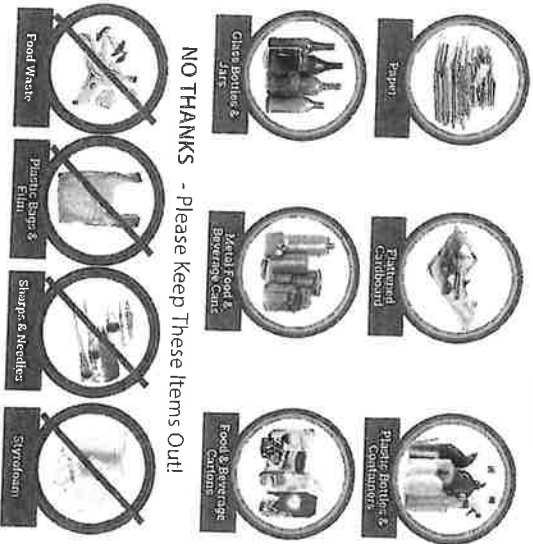
- Optional Service
- Monthly Collection = **\$5.00** per month
- Limit 10 paper bags or containers/pickup per month. Resident rigid containers acceptable, labeled "Yard Waste"
- Limbs cannot be longer than 4' & 18" in diameter. All non-containerized yard waste must be tied or bundled.



Recycling Guidelines:

- Recycling service is provided weekly to each residence as part of base service
- 1 96 gallon cart is provided as part of base service
- All materials must fit inside the cart
- Residents are encouraged to review the acceptable materials list provided below
- Please exclude all food waste, plastic bags and styrofoam from the recycling cart. Please take your plastic bags to your local grocery store for recycling. Please break down and collapse all cardboard boxes before placing them in your recycling cart.
- Please rinse out all food containers before recycling

Holiday Schedule: solid waste services do not operate on the following days:

- New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

*If the holiday occurs on your scheduled collection day, services will be delayed one day for the remainder of the week.

Optional Services

Over Limit Yard Waste Service: Residents may be charged an additional \$10 for anything over their 10 bags/containers limit.

Over Limit Bulky Waste: There is a charge of \$10.00 per item over the 1-item limit per week. Customer can place 2 bulky items out on the last trash pickup day of the month.

Appliance Recycling: Appliances can be scheduled for recycling by calling Waste Management in advance. A charge of \$25.00 per item applies.

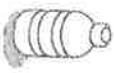

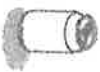
